CHRISTMAS TREE COLLECTION

On **YOUR** specific collection day between the dates of January 6-16, 2025

SPRING METAL COLLECTION

On **YOUR** specific collection day between the dates of April 8-18, 2025.

FALL METAL COLLECTION

On **YOUR** specific collection day between the dates of October 7-17, 2025.

METAL COLLECTION is for METAL ITEMS ONLY!

Items containing freon must be taken to the Materials Recovery Facility. Other bulky items (except for wood and wood furniture) can be placed with your regular collection throughout the year.

Items NOT collected curbside:



Electronics – all small appliances (toaster, microwave, blender), personal care appliances, vacuums, computers, printers, fans, phones and audio and visual equipment must be taken to the EPRA depot at 108 King Street (across from the Shelburne Mall) to be recycled.



Construction waste, such as wood, shingles, flooring and insulation must be taken to the Regional Materials Recovery Facility, 4571, Hwy 3, West Green Harbour. Visit www.municipalityofshelburne.ca for tipping fees.



Household Hazardous Waste (HHW) Propane tanks, paint cans, aerosol cans and other household hazardous waste items are to be taken to the Hazardous Waste Depot at 243 Sandy Point Road, on the 1st and 3rd Monday of each month for proper disposal from: 9 am – 1 pm and 2 – 4 pm.



Tires - can be returned, up to four at a time, to any tire retailer. Tires must be off the rim and free of mud and debris.

ORGANICS (GREEN CART)



All food waste including meat, fish, dairy, bones, fruit, vegetables, coffee filters and tea bags.

Wet and dirty paper, paper towel, napkins, coffee cups, tissues, pizza boxes.



Plant material, leaf and yard waste, saw dust, wood chips.

Absolutely NO plastic bags, metals or glass are permitted in the green cart. Biodegradable bags **MUST** have this logo to be accepted:



RECYCLING (BLUE BAGS ONLY)

Blue bag # 1 - Paper products



Paper/boxboard, newspaper, magazines, cereal and cracker boxes. Non-metallic wrapping paper. Frozen food and pasta boxes, tissue box, books and phone books.

Blue bag # 2 - Recyclable containers

Plastic containers such as condiments, milk, peanut butter and yogurt. Plastic bags such as bread, cereal and produce bags. Beverage containers including milk and creamers, clean coffee cups and all glass, metal and tin cans.



ALL recyclables should be clean and dry to avoid rejection.

Please use **BLUE BAGS** for **ALL** your recyclables.

Paper can be left on tin cans, windows in envelopes, and plastic on Kleenex boxes.

GARBAGE (CLEAR BAGS ONLY)



Pet waste including kitty litter, Styrofoam, toothpaste tubes, diapers, broken toys.

Pet food bags, candy bar wrappers, binders, strawberry and clementine boxes



Broken glass, mattress, box spring, upholstered furniture.

Absolutely no organics or recyclables are to be placed in your clear garbage bags.

Do not use feed bags, dog food bags, or other such bags as a garbage bag.

Household batteries can be dropped off at the Municipality offices.
