

RESOLVED BY THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF LOCKEPORT PURSUANT TO SECTION 169 OF CHAPTER 309 OF THE REVISED STATUTES OF NOVA SCOTIA, 1967, THE TOWN'S ACT THAT THE FOLLOWING BY-LAW BE AND THE SAME IS HEREBY ENACTED AND THAT THE CLERK BE AND IS HEREBY INSTRUCTED TO FORWARD SAME TO THE MINISTER OF MUNICIPAL AFFAIRS AND THE MINISTER OF HIGHWAYS WITH A REQUEST FOR THEIR APPROVALS HEREOF.

By-Law Number 34

CLOSING A PORTION OF WATER STREET

1. THAT THE COUNCIL DO CLOSE TO PUBLIC USE A PORTION OF A STREET KNOWN AS WATER STREET.
2. THAT THE PORTION OF THE SAID STREET HEREBY CLOSED TO PUBLIC USE PURSUANT TO SECTION 1 OF THIS BY-LAW IS AS OUTLINED IN RED ON THE SURVEY PLAN ATTACHED HERETO AND MARKED " SCHEDULE A ".
3. THAT THE PORTION OF WATER STREET AS DESCRIBED IN SECTION 2 OF THIS BY-LAW BE CLOSED AND THAT ALL RIGHTS OF PUBLIC USER HERETOFORE AS A STREET IN THE LANDS HEREINBEFORE MORE PARTICULARLY DESCRIBED ARE FOREVER EXTINGUISHED AND THE TOWN MAY SELL AND CONVEY THE PORTION SO CLOSED.
