BY-LAW NUMBER 31

BY-LAW PROHIBITING DISTURBANCE

Any person who creates a disturbance by shouting, screaming, fighting or being the driver of a motor vehicle that makes a loud noise by squealing the wheels of a motor vehicle by acceleration, contrary to the by-laws of the Town of Lockeport, Shelburne County, Nova Scotia, is subject to a fine of ~~not less than \$25.00 and not more than \$100.00.~~ *not approved*
